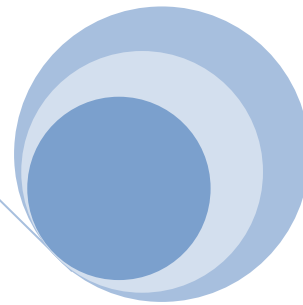
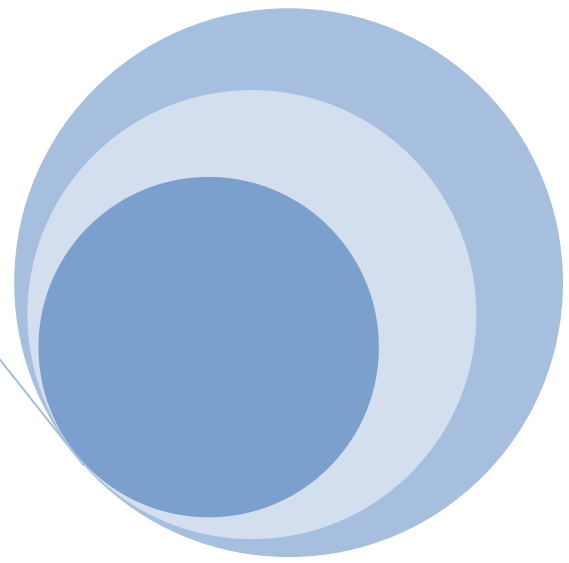
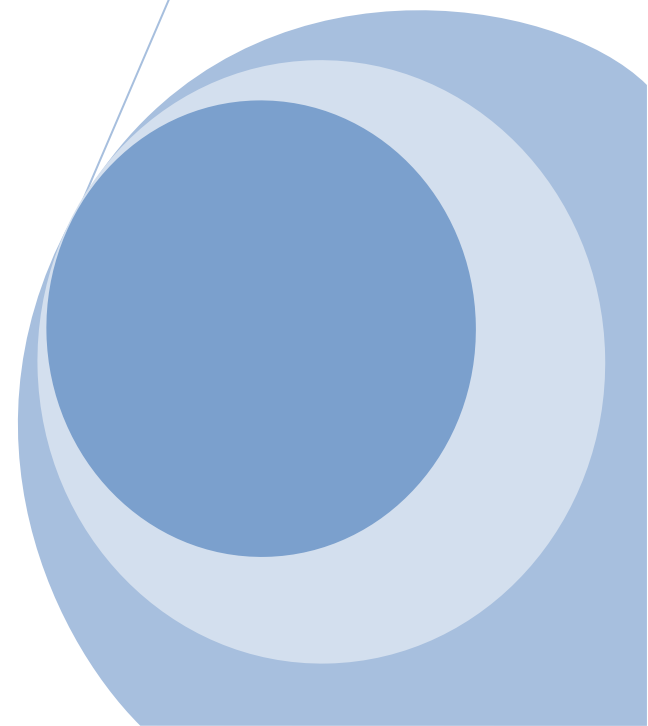

Beneath One Sky is a non-profit group devoted to raising awareness and taking initiative to conquer poverty in our neighbourhood and around the world.

"Vancouver has the highest percent of population with low income; the highest percent of working poor families; and the largest and fastest growing income gap between rich and poor. Welfare income [is] also very low in Vancouver, and Vancouver had the second highest number of households which paid more than 30% of their income for rent and/or lived in inadequate housing. Vancouver was also worst for "community affordability." That means that the combination of low income plus high cost of living makes the poorest fifth of Vancouver residents worse off than those in other cities."

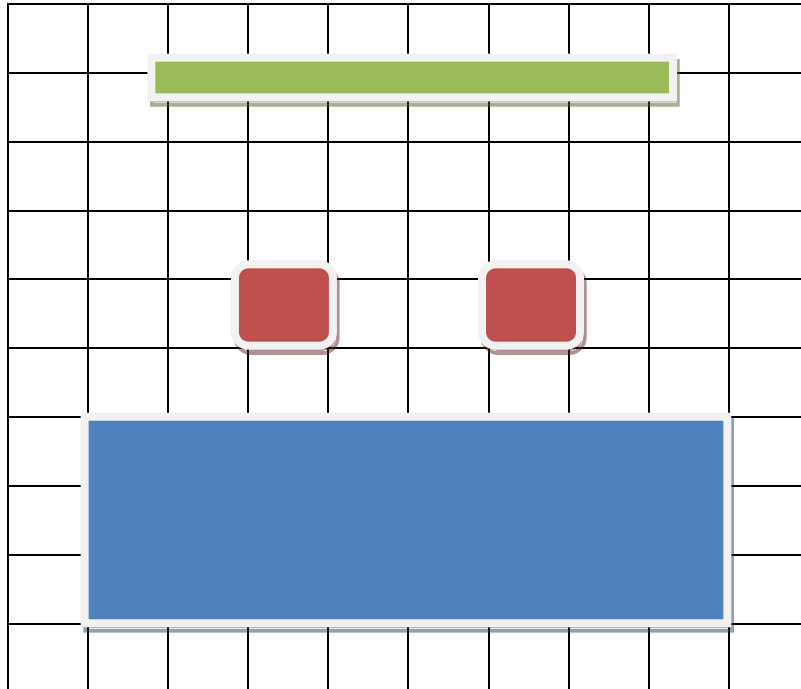

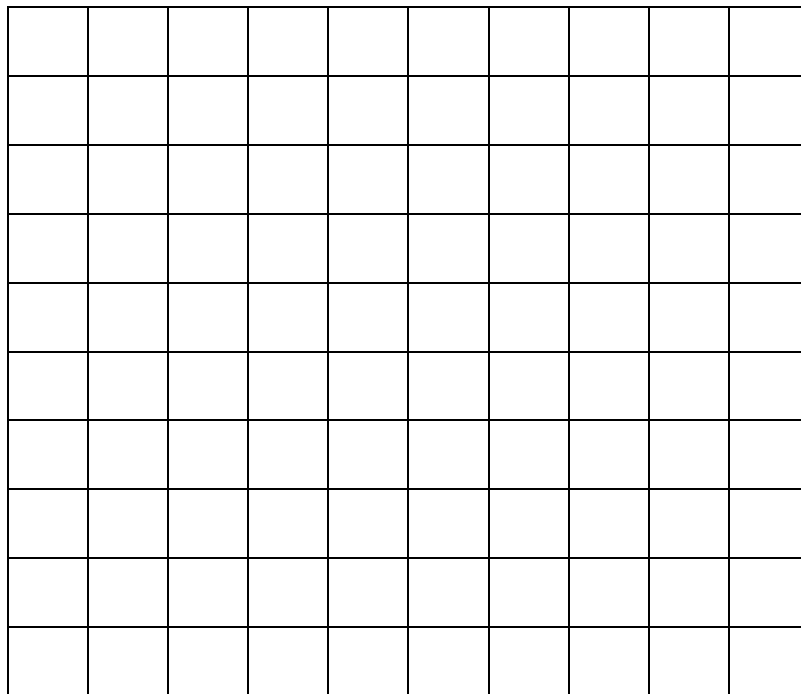

Beneath One Sky Spring Fest on Campus Participation Guidelines

Beneath One Sky promotes a strong sense of community among the diverse people of our community. Our mission is to raise awareness of poverty and taking initiative to conquer it in our neighbour and around the world. All proceeds from the Beneath One Sky Spring Fest on Campus will go towards our programs to stop poverty. Our goals for this three day event are:

- To welcome all members of the community to Beneath One Sky Spring Fest on Campus, including students.
- To offer performing artists rooted in the community an opportunity to engage in and showcase local performances.
- To give members of the community a chance to support local merchants, artists, entrepreneurs, and the like.
- To give students a chance to have fun and take a break before the beginning of exams.
- To raise awareness of the issue of poverty in our community, locally and globally.

Participation in the Beneath One Sky Spring Fest on Campus

Businesses and community organizations who embrace the mission of the Beneath One Sky Spring Fest on Campus are welcome to participate in this event.

1. Organizations and businesses wishing to purchase 10'x10' booth space must submit an application, available online at <http://beneathonesky.org/sfu/springfest/form/>. Participants will be notified of their acceptance to participate in a timely manner. Note: Convocation mall has a policy of being commercial free. Any sales conducted must be approved by the Spring Fest Committee, and proceeds must go towards a good cause (ex. fundraising for organization/club, free trade, partial proceeds donating to charity, etc.)
2. All participants may make special requests for a booth location. We will try to accommodate these requests; however we cannot guarantee them unless they are priority premium sponsors. Applications that are rejected will receive a full refund.
3. All Beneath One Sky Spring Fest on Campus participants are expected to respect others, accepting of diverse people and presentations and performances, and comply with these guidelines. Those who do not comply will be asked to leave, and will not be eligible for participation in the future.
4. All participants must keep their booth occupied during the whole event, or must inform Spring Fest Staff member(s) if they must leave their booth unattended for an extended amount of time. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
